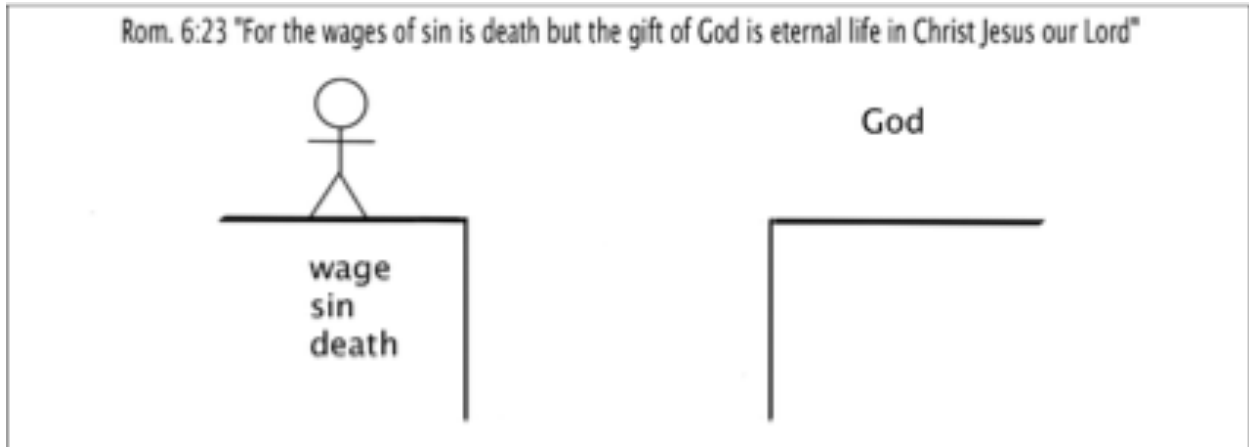


“For the wages of sin is death”

lets take 3 from Exodus 20

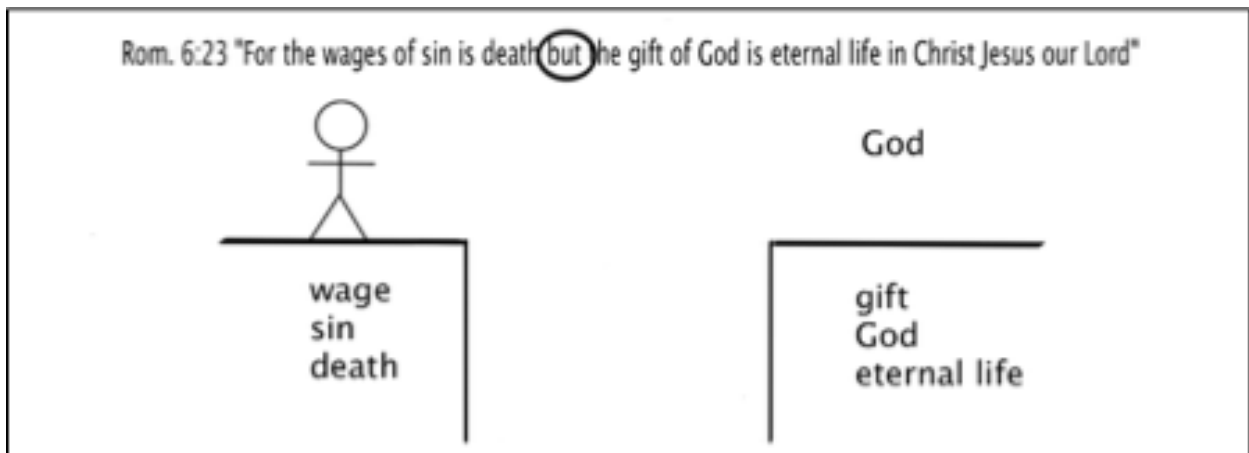
- do not bear false witness

-eternal death / hell!

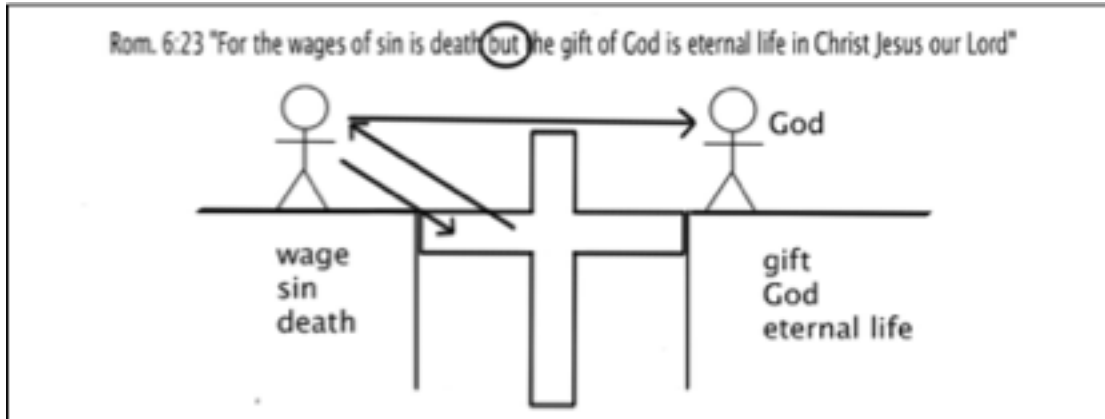
“but the gift of God is eternal life”

-a substitute

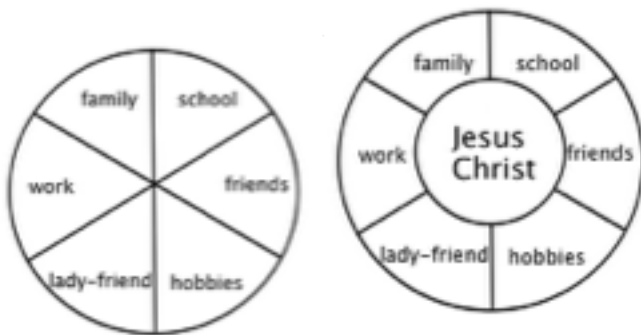
“in Christ Jesus our Lord”
